LAWNS & GRASSES	<p>ESTABLISHED LAWN: Make a 1 gallon concentrate of Bu's Brew™ for every 250-300 sq ft of lawn. Use a hose-end or backpack sprayer to apply.</p> <p>NEW SOD: Apply tea to new sod approximately 4-5 weeks after installing. Use 1 gallon of Bu's Brew™ for every 250-300 sq ft. Apply with a hose-end or back-pack sprayer.</p> <p>NEW SEED: Follow the directions above for new sod once the lawn becomes established.</p>
CITRUS & AVOCADO TREES	<p>FOLIAR FEED the leaves or ROOT DRENCH, using 1/2 to 1 gallon (more for larger trees) around the drip-line. Apply the month after applying Bu's Blend™.</p>
ROSES	<p>FOLIAR FEED: Apply Bu's Buds™ as a foliar spray when new leaves first appear in spring.</p> <p>ROOT DRENCH: Water once a month with Bu's Buds™ from March to October.</p>
BUSHES & SHRUBS	<p>ROOT DRENCH with Bu's Brew™ the month after compost application.</p>
EDIBLES	<p>FOLIAR FEED: Foliar feed with Bu's Brew™ or Bu's Best™ approximately 3-4 weeks after planting, then again as often as desired throughout the season</p> <p>ROOT DRENCH: Water with Bu's Brew™ or Bu's Best™ approximately 3-4 weeks after planting, then again as often as desired throughout the season</p> <p>TRANSPLANT SHOCK REDUCER: If possible, dunk entire root ball into Bu's Brew™ or Bu's Best™ prior to planting.</p>
SUCCULENTS & DROUGHT-TOLERANT	<p>TRANSPLANT SHOCK REDUCER: Dunk entire root ball in Bu's Brew™ before planting or water the planting hole with prepared tea before planting.</p>
TREES	<p>ROOT DRENCH: Water in with Bu's Brew™ the month after applying Bu's Blend™ Biodynamic Compost.</p>
IMMUNE BOOSTER	<p>FOLIAR FEED: Foliar feed with Bu's Brew™, Bu's Best™, or Bu's Buds™ at the first sign of disease and again up to once a week until symptoms subside. Provide a bigger boost by also using prepared tea as a ROOT DRENCH.</p>



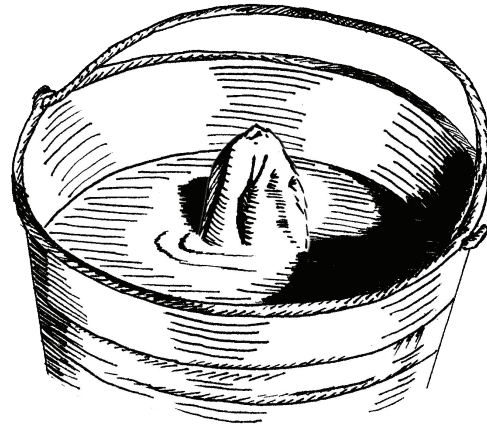
HOW TO BREW COMPOST TEA

SOAK - SQUEEZE - STIR - SERVE

STEP 1: SOAK

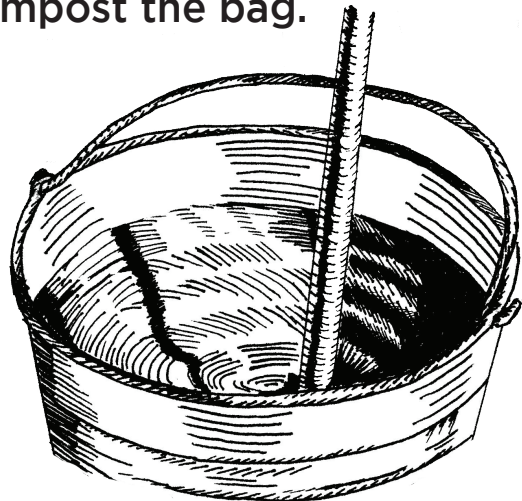
Soak one teabag in 1 to 5 gallons of water* for 8-18 hours. Use an aerator, if you'd like.

**Chlorine/chloramine-free water is ideal*



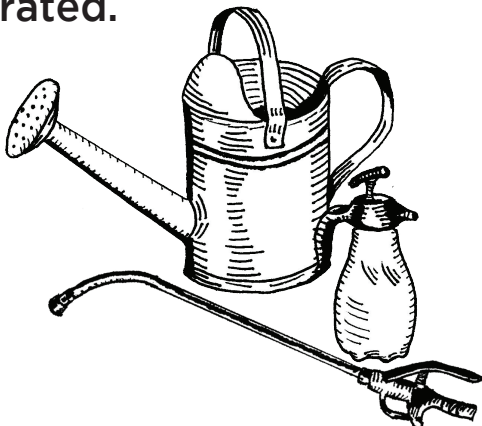
STEP 2: SQUEEZE

Remove & squeeze out teabag. Dunk & squeeze again. Compost the bag.



STEP 3: STIR

Stir vigorously in one direction, then change direction every 30 seconds until tea is frothy & aerated.



STEP 4: SERVE

Pour around plant base, apply to the underside of the leaves (using a sprayer), or dunk transplant roots when planting.
