What is CSA? CSA is community supported agriculture & is a dynamic farm movement more than twenty years old, summed up as share the bounty, share the risk... or perhaps better said in sickness & in health. CSA engages farmer & consumer in a relationship in which consumer members pledge annually to pay a share of the farm's economic needs & in return receive a share of the produce in weekly harvests, as well as other farm-specific benefits. Early pledges & payments provide funds for expenses incurred before harvesting begins & throughout season. We are the longest running & oldest CSA in Nebraska... we do other farmy things but it is still the heartbeat of our farm!

2014 CSA Details Members support the farm paying a share of the budget & receive a share of the season's harvest as a weekly harvest box, picked-up from a delivery site or on-farm. Included with harvests is a delightful newsletter sharing farm news, recipes & produce info. Harvest shares are c. 10 - 12 lbs/week over the season. Season is mid/late May – early August. We offer 12 weeks of harvest for the summer share & 15 weeks for the extended summer share. As is the nature of farming, there are variables beyond our control. Generally this is adequate for a family of 4 or 2 vegetarians; remember, this is just a guideline. Too much? Find a partner & share the harvest (see form: \$20 partner fee). Summer CSA cost is \$360. Extended Summer CSA is \$450. A signed pledge form & deposit (\$180) or full payment reserves a share. Suggested deadline is February 15. Early pledges are important & help with planning! Subsequent payment for the balance is due by June 1, 2014. 70 shares are available for 2014. Harvest pick up on-farm or locations in Lincoln, Mondays or Thursdays from 3:30 PM – 6:30 PM.
